This experience has been invaluable to his current role of sales and service. Sheldon is based in central Alberta where he works with various types of farms and customers. He supports the Alberta multiplier farm with selection of gilts at Kingdom Farms to ensure customers receive top-quality gilts. Though based in Central Alberta, you can see Sheldon working trade shows and visiting pig barns in Southern Alberta, South-west Saskatchewan, and Montana.



Russ Penner handles sales and technical support in Manitoba. Having owned a 1,500-sow production farm, Russ is very competent in production support of our products. In addition to a sales and service role, Russ also looks after one of our multiplier pyramids, Stanley Pork and Grass River. Regular visits to both sites are done to assure health and quality control as well as give

support and advice on how to produce the best product for sale to our customers.



Ron Musick is the Canadian Export and Logistics manager. Ron manages the company's breeding stock supply chain and logistics operations. One of Ron's main roles is the coordination of exports and imports of live breeding stock in and out of Canada. Topigs Norsvin Canada is proud to have the highest ranked Z-line and TN Tempo populations in the Topigs Norsvin global system. That leads to a demand for live exports of both gilts

and boars to support genetic progress in other countries. The logistics and health certificates vary greatly between countries and take a considerable amount of time from start to completion with animals arriving safely at their destination.



Annika Armstrong assists Ron in logistics and coordinates the domestic shipments in Canada and the USA. She helps organize the company's breeding stock supply/ demand to keep the sales team current with availabilities. She also assists in the health department by tracking all lab testing results. In the marketing department, Annika assists John Sawatzky with various tasks which include coordinating

trade shows, updating social media, and keeping advertising up to date in different publications throughout Canada.





Walter Klochko is also a member of the export/logistics team with Ron and Annika. Walter manages all three of our isolation barns, with help from Ryan David. Whenever there are international exports that require an isolation period, this team prepares the isolation barns for

CFIA inspections prior to animals entering the isolation barns. Once approved and animals are in guarantine, they care for the animals while they are in isolation, administer vaccinations, help prepare and participate in testing and selection. Once the isolation period is over, they load the final selected export group onto trucks for delivery to meet a plane at an airport which could be Chicago, Winnipeg or even Hamilton, Ontario. Once empty, the barn is washed, disinfected and prepared for the next export. This team is also in charge of caring for any boars that are imported from the US during their guarantine time. Walter is responsible for moving nucleus farm by-product animals to brokers and packers.



Paradise Valley nucleus, then moved on to the Genetic Nucleus Production Manager, and is now the Key Account Technical Manager. As the Key Account Technical Manager, Marcos visits and supports key accounts of Topigs Norsvin Canada where he organizes and analyzes data to increase the production

output and efficiency of customer production systems. Marcos ensures there is dataflow between multiplier farms and Topigs Norsvin Canada and is also responsible for the support and development of InGene® in customer farms.



Genetic Services & Research

Mike Shaw, Director of Genetic Services, is responsible for our Genetic Nucleus pyramids in Canada. He oversees the genetics program, production, human resources, and operations at these nucleus farms. Mike was the project manager of our Delta Canada Research Barn from conception to completion in 2018, and is now focusing on new special

projects. Mike is also involved with some of our key accounts in



Canada and Mexico focusing on production and genetic program support.

Genetic and Health Program Manager, Justin Reimer oversees the genetic program within Topigs Norsvin Canada. Working in a role of both genetic data and actual "barn level" phenotypic information, Justin's role is to make sure the characteristics we deem as essential

in each breed line is maximized to its fullest potential. These essential characteristics are portrayed in a numerical value which we call the TSI (Topigs Selection Index). Justin breaks the TSI down into its individual characteristics to ensure they are strong throughout the Genetic Nucleus system. This process applies not only to Canada, Justin also participates in a Global Selection Team to ensure our products are very similar around the world. Justin visits all the Nucleus barns to keep an eye on the strength of their genetic program. He also monitors boar placements to all AI studs in Canada to ensure the productive herd meets the genetic criteria for all our breed lines. Justin works with the veterinarians in the health program to monitor health testing and protocols our nucleus and multiplier barns.









Three key people are part of Justin's team. Yang Liu, Lee-Anna Murray, and Mikala **Sasley** assist in testing, data flow and monitoring information between our nucleus barns and the head office. Various genetics tests and sampling are done routinely including Lean Muscle Scanning, weighing of animals and DNA sampling. Being in nucleus farms every week, Lee-Anna and Mikala also head up our weekly meat quality testing done in the lab at our head office. Yang focuses on Key Account barns to make sure protocols are followed. He is also in charge of leading the InGene® process for customers across Canada.

Victor Lei oversees all the Topigs Norsvin Canada Research and

Development activities, and manages research projects within the R&D department. Victor has built and maintained a direct link between R&D departments and the Topigs Norsvin International research group where he collaborates with different Topigs Norsvin genetics groups from around the world. Victor directs and oversees the quality of data collection and the selection program which includes CT scanning, automatic feed intake recording, and other precision phenotype protocols.



Veterinary & Health

On January 1, 2021, Dr. Brad **Chappell** joined our team to become the Director of Veterinary Services for Topigs Norsvin Canada. Dr. Chappell is responsible for health programs within Canada. Brad makes weekly herd visits to nucleus and multiplier barns to ensure the health of the herd is being monitored regularly

to ensure the highest health.



Production

Claude Verrier, Genetic Nucleus Production Manager, works on production with all our nucleus farms. Direct contact with barn staff and reviewing production data daily ensures everything is flowing properly. Claude helped with the Paradise Valley renovations.



Our dedicated barn staff is vital to successful production. Our two main Genetic Nucleus farms are Windy Acres and Paradise Valley. Windy Acres is managed by Matthew Waldner where he and his team produce some of the best terminal sires available today. TN Tempo, TN Talent and Norsvin Duroc boars are produced here for sale and distribution to AI stations in Canada, the USA and the world.

Paradise Valley is our maternal Genetic Nucleus managed by **Anna Tobias**. Anna and her team produce the Z-line and Norsvin Landrace. The Z-lines at Paradise Valley are ranked the highest in the world and are in big demand to produce TN70 gilts.

barns approximately 30 km away. The Delta Nursery site is managed by Harry Waldner and his team, Earl Villanueva, and Victor Billan. These barns get filled in a rotation every three weeks with Z-line and TN Tempo boars from our nucleus barns. This team covers all aspects of production including basic feeding and care, health checks, and general barn duties. All pigs are identified with RFID tags and a DNA sample registered in our database. The staff makes sure that all identification is correct.

Each week the Delta Nursery sends the best 144 Z-line and TN Tempo boars to Delta Canada which is managed by Alex Yanguez. Here the boars are grown out to 130 kg when they are off-tested. Alex and his team conduct many different tests on each boar such as a Live Muscle Scan, CT Scanning, and health tests prior to being on our Z-line and TN Tempo boars. Most boars at Delta Canada are selected for different international exports.



AIM Worldwide

Kyla Ripley, AIM Worldwide-AI Specialist Americas, oversees AIM services which includes setup and execution of plans to improve semen collection, processing and efficiency of owned, contracted and key account AI stations inside the Americas. This includes the monitoring of AIM standards

through on site auditing and the implementation of a third party Quality Control Andrology program. Kyla assists in the development of training programs for new and existing partnership AI stations, and she supports the implementation of new techniques and software solutions. Kyla also contributes from a market perspective to the reproduction and fertility research platform through setup and support of research projects in practice with AIM customer boar studs.



PARADISE VALLEY RENOVATIONS





For many years now, group housing of sows has been practiced in Topigs Norsvin nucleus farms in Norway and The Netherlands. All animals in our maternal line genetic programs have been selected in a group environment for more than a decade. The Paradise Valley Genetic Nucleus in Manitoba is now the highest ranked maternal nucleus within the whole of Topigs Norsvin worldwide. To continue the work started many years ago, and to meet the standard of group sow housing, a major renovation took place in the latter part of 2020.

After several delays due to equipment not arriving on time and COVID-19 issues, construction finally began August 17, 2020. The construction and renovations were completed in only 128 days. The planning team spent many long days planning and organizing these renovations to ensure they were properly done, that biosecurity was not compromised, and that the design and equipment equaled or exceeded the Topigs

Norsvin standard. This planning team included Mike Shaw, Russ Penner, Claude Verrier, and Jeroen Van Boekel.

Paradise Valley was built in 1996 and, as with all barns this age, most of the equipment had been in the barn for years, so this was a good time for an upgrade. Renovations occurred in the gilt rooms, breeding rooms and gestation rooms. Each room received new slatted floors, which were converted in the gestation room from partially slatted floors to fully slatted floors, new water lines, a fresh coat of paint and upgraded lighting and ventilation. The heating systems were also upgraded to floor and tube heating in the gestation rooms to help keep the animals warm in the cold Manitoba winters. The group sow housing was installed with free access feeding

Not only did our Topigs Norsvin Canada team put a lot of their time and effort into these renovations, so did our contactors: A2 Ventures Inc. completed the construction aspects of the renovations; Golf View Electric completed the electrical work; Summit Technology upgraded the Maximus ventilation controllers; After Hours Plumbing and Heating updated the heaters in the gestation room; and MK Painting helped give the barn a fresh coat of paint. We would like to thank everyone who helped us with the Paradise Valley renovations. Without all the long days and hard work, this project never could have been completed with such speed and efficiency.
